Beyond the Highway Code, it is important to respect and get others to respect the Guidelines for Preventing Road Accidents:



GIVE PRIORITY TO **REMOTE MEETINGS** INSTEAD OF TRAVELING.



DO NOT DRIVE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF **DRUGS OR ALCOHOL.**



PLAN **JOURNEYS** IN ADVANCE.



ONLY DRIVE WHEN **WELL ENOUGH** TO DO SO.



GIVE PRIORITY TO **PUBLIC TRANSPORT** OR MAKE SURE TO USE **SAFE, MAINTAINED AND APPROPRIATE VEHICLES.**



DO NOT USE **MOBILE PHONES OR OTHER COMMUNICATION DEVICES** WHEN DRIVING.



MAKE SURE YOU HAVE A **VALID LICENSE AND INSURANCE.**



AVOID DRIVING **BETWEEN 10PM AND 6AM** WHEN TRAVELING FOR WORK REASONS.



TAKE A BREAK **EVERY 2 HOURS** OR AT THE **FIRST SIGNS OF TIREDNESS** DURING LONG CAR JOURNEYS.



DO NOT USE A **MOPED/SCOOTER OR MOTORBIKE** WITHOUT **TRAINING AND APPROVAL FROM YOUR COMPANY** WHEN TRAVELING FOR WORK REASONS.
