In 1998, he became Assembly Line Manager on the CFM56 manufacturing program. In 2005, Christophe is appointed Head of Programs in interface with Airframers and he is also responsible of the propulsion systems integration along certification to entry into service. In 2012, he became Commercial Engines Quality Director. In 2015, he is appointed Commercial Engines Production VP.

Christophe GUERET, 54, is a graduate from INSA Lyon (1989).



**Patrick Joyez** started his career in 1995 within the Rocket Engines Division of Snecma<sup>1</sup> successively acting as Project Design Engineer and then

Engineering Team Leader for space composites products. In 2001, he joined the Engineering Direction as Head of the Military HP turbines Mechanical Design Unit and subsequently of the In-Service engines Turbine Design Department. In 2005, Patrick became Deputy VP Quality. In 2008, he came back to the Engineering Direction as Chief Engineer of CFM56 engines and then Director of the Propulsion System Integration. In 2014, he is appointed Chief Engineer for the three LEAP engine models and for the Silvercrest engine in 2018.

Patrick JOYEZ, 49, is a graduate from Ecole Centrale Paris (1994).
