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What exactly does a system architect do?

System architects design the structure of a system that combines different techniques or technologies (mechanical, electronic, software, etc.). They specify the components to be used, in conjunction with the company's own specialists in these areas, plus outside suppliers. They take a holistic viewpoint of the system, and are involved right from the operational definition of components and subassemblies, as well as the system itself. They guarantee that the system meets immediate customer requirements, or addresses strategic requirements for upcoming products.

What challenges does this position entail?

System architects work closely with the Product division, helping to draw up the product road map and foster new innovations. They also act as the technical authority on all systems under their responsibility.

What makes a job like this interesting?

This product design process allows system architects to develop their knowledge of many different technical aspects, making this a truly cross-disciplinary position. Furthermore, because of their wide range of responsibilities, they are in contact with people from many different horizons.
